Longbridges Boat House River Isis, Oxford

Green Templeton part-owns Longbridges Boathouse on the River Thames (the stretch locally referred to as The Isis) along with Hertford, Mansfield, St. Hilda's, St. Catherine's, and St. Benet's colleges. Longbridges provides a number of important services to GTBC members and supporters. It affords a great view of the regattas and events held on the Isis, and our crews regularly train in its state-of-the-art erg room, furnished with 12 brand new erg machines.

Getting to Longbridges from Green Templeton College is straightforward. As you leave the main college gates, turn right into Woodstock Road. Continue down this road; it will become St. Giles and then Cornmarket Street (the main street in Oxford). Travel through Cornmarket Street and continue down St. Aldates. Go past the Head of the River pub and over Folly Bridge. Immediately after the bridge there are pedestrian lights. Turn left at these lights and go down a ramp onto the 'tow path' (the gravel road next to the river). Follow this tow path and, after about 1km, you will arrive at Longbridges.

Please make sure that you leave sufficient time to travel to get from the college to the boat house!
